sx<sup>w</sup>amisaat Chief Laura Cassidy has served as elected chief of Tsawwassen First Nation (TFN) since October 15, 2022. Chief Cassidy currently occupies TFN's seat at the table of Metro Vancouver Board of Directors, and a seat on Translink's Mayors Council. She also sits as a Board Member for Delta Police.

Before she was elected as Chief, sx<sup>w</sup>amisaat was elected as an Executive Council Member for 20 years at TFN. She also was Manager of Natural Resources for TFN for 10 years and was a negotiator for the Tsawwassen First Nation Final agreement (Treaty) which came into effect on April 3, 2009. In addition to her many demonstrations of stewardship, she also served one term as a proud Board Member for Delta Hospital Foundation.

Chief Cassidy's core values focus on community safety and wellness, as well as economic stability for the Nation. She also greatly values continued education for scəwəθən məsteyəx<sup>w</sup> Tsawwassen peoples. She loves cultural gatherings and activities, as community is very important to her. Chief Cassidy was born and raised on Tsawwassen lands and has a growing family of 4 children and 4 grandchildren.
