



2024 GVBOT Corporate Cup Tournament Details

Schedule:

Wednesday, July 17, 2024

11:30 a.m. – Arrive at the Stadium

12:30 - 4:00 p.m. – GVBOT Corporate Cup

7:30 p.m. – Vancouver Whitecaps vs Sporting Kansas FC

General Info:

- Players will be provided with Orange wrist bands.
- Spectators will be provided with Green wrist bands.
- 6 v 6 Co-ed (5 outfield + 1 goalkeeper).
- 2 women must be on the pitch at all times.
- Each team is allowed a maximum roster size of 15.
- Water will be provided for participants. Please bring refillable drinking containers.
- All participants must complete a waiver.
- Changing areas will be designated for player use.
- All teams are asked to wear similar coloured shirts/jerseys while playing. Pinnies will be provided if necessary.
- First aid will be available on-site. Safety is top priority. We stress that this is a FUN & FRIENDLY tournament. Any behaviour that does not comply with this will be cause for immediate dismissal from BC Place.
- All players and spectators must leave BC Place after the tournament and can return when gates open for the 7:30 p.m. match against Minnesota United.

Registration:

- Spectators wishing to watch the games can do so from the stands.
- Team registration will take place at gate C beginning at 11:30 a.m.
- All players must complete and sign the waiver form. Spectators will not be required to fill out the waiver.

Tournament Format:

- 4 team round-robin group phase – each team will have a minimum of 3 matches.
- Winner of each group will advance to the knock-out round.
- Field will be divided into 4 separate fields.
- One referee per pitch, plus a 4th official (WCFC staff) centrally located for score keeping and organizations purposes.
- Matches will be 20 minutes long, with no half time changes or end changes.

Tiebreak format:

- Sudden death penalty shoot-out, no player can shoot twice until all other players have shot once.

Rules of Play:

- Slides are not allowed.
- In the event of a referee issuing a yellow card, the player is ejected from the match and must serve an additional one match suspension.
- In the event of a referee issuing a red card, the player will be eliminated from the tournament.
- Players who are suspected of being intoxicated will not be allowed to participate.
- No outside food or drink is permitted in BC Place. Please eat after or prior to the start.
- Matches will begin and end on the referee's whistle.
- Referee has final say on all calls.
- FIFA rules apply. All participants are required to wear proper footwear/cleats (no 6 studs), shin pads, socks, shorts, and shirt. The referee will be enforcing this rule and may ask and individual to remain off the pitch if they are not uniform compliant.
- Substitutions can be made on the fly without notifying the referee.
