Introduction & Overview

What is a Peer Leadership Forum (PLF)?

Like-minded people gather at Peer Leadership Forums (PLFs) for conversation to learn and share experiences, stories, goals, knowledge and wisdom for the benefit of themselves and others. PLF's bring young professionals together to find innovative solutions to common barriers.

How do CYP Peer Leadership Forums work?

PLFs are discussion groups (of 10-15 people) which get together monthly to share ideas, personal goals, and insights shared by industry leaders. The result is new friendships, new perspectives, and a lot of fun. Each PLF team is a diverse team of emerging leaders representing a wide variety of industries. Through PLF's, you gain perspective from other like-minded motivated young professionals who want to see you succeed!

What is the expected commitment of PLF Members?

- Attend at least 70% or 5 / 7 annual team meetings.
- Attend the PLF Kickoff event (Sept 29) and Connect event (January 28).
- Host one team meeting per year includes managing venue, meeting agenda, and snacks (Approx. \$50).
- Participate in an annual Community Outreach initiative with your team.

How do I enroll in a CYP Peer Leadership Forum?

Peer Leadership Forums are formed every September and January. Members are invited to complete an online application at this time. Teams run from September to May and are formed based on age / life stage, industry diversity and team member goals.
